Attire:	Proper attire consisting of sports shoes and sports apparel is required. The tournament director reserves the right to disqualify participants if failure to comply with the rules.
Equipment:	Rackets and shuttles (for practice) must be provided by participants. Yonex 30 shuttlecocks for the tournament will be provided.
Entries:	Each team entry must be filled out by the coach. Forms are attached at the end of this document.

Matches:	Men's singles, men's doubles, women's doubles, and mixed doubles will be played in best two out of three games rally scoring according to current USA Badminton rules.
