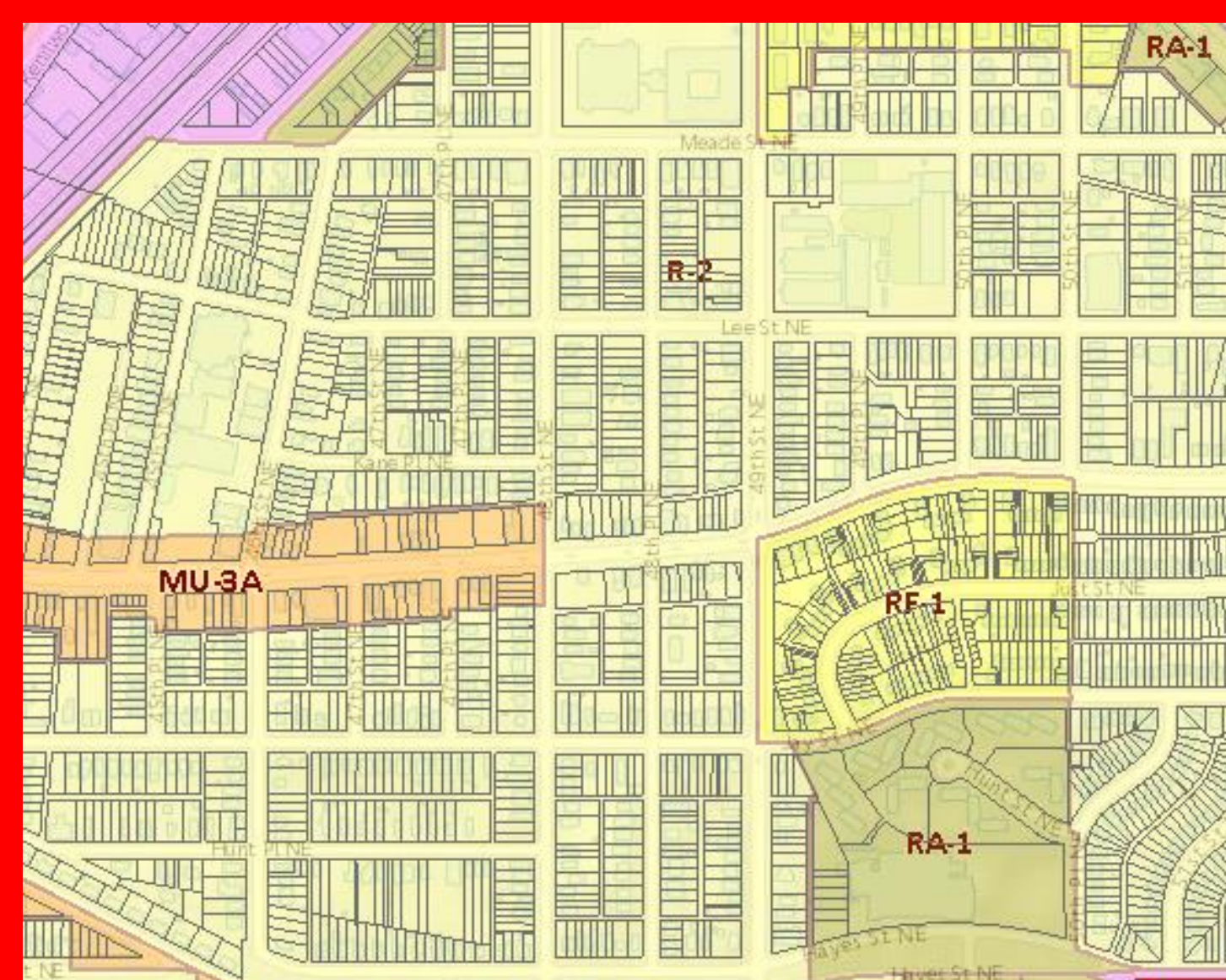
My research was conducted virtually, through continual guidance by UMDCP Architecture, Planning, and Preservation professor Wayne Curtis
